And when did we see You a stranger, and invite You in, or naked, and clothe You? When did we see You sick, or in prison, and come to You?’ The King will answer and say to them, ‘Truly I say to you, to the extent that you did it to one of these brothers of Mine, even the least of them, you did it to Me.’”</i></p>	<p>Matthew 25:34-40</p>
27.	<p>God’s Will, Not Yours, Be Done <i>“And He went a little beyond them, and fell on His face and prayed, saying, ‘My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me, yet not as I will, but as You will.’”</i> The night before His crucifixion, Jesus was suffering as He knew what was coming; nevertheless, He continued in His complete obedience to God’s will. Jesus did not beg nor plead but with incredible anguish surrendered Himself to God saying: <i>“as You will.”</i> This takes complete trust in God that no matter the pain, God’s outcome will be delivered. Note: The “cup” Jesus refers to is the metaphorical cup of suffering and separation that contained His body’s blood, to be shed during His crucifixion- blood that would pay the price for our sins to be forgiven.</p>	<p>Matthew 26:39</p>

29.	<p>God’s Will <i>“For this is the will of God, your sanctification; that is, that you abstain from sexual immorality; that each of you know how to possess his own vessel in sanctification and honor, not in lustful passion, like the Gentiles who do not know God; and that no man transgress and defraud his brother in the matter because the Lord is the avenger in all these things, just as we also told you before and solemnly warned you. For God has not called us for the purpose of impurity, but in sanctification.
